-  A web profile on **WinterArtisanFair.com** (Website goes live by January 6, 2026 with your profile). Each vendor will provide 3-5 photos of them and/or other work in digital format (.jpg preferred). Each page will include a bio, short business description, a video or still (see below), 3 photos and contact info.
-  If you do not have a business video and wish to have one for the WinterArtisanFair.com website, one (1) optional one-minute+ video will be created for you by Jamie Spooner of Greenlight Interactive. Jamie will come on-site to film and interview you. All videos will need to be completed by January 10. If no video is needed or available, a still photo will be used in its place.
-  Promotion on a Facebook Event page and other marketing efforts.

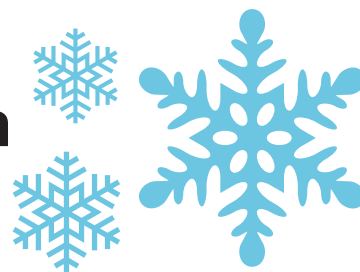
